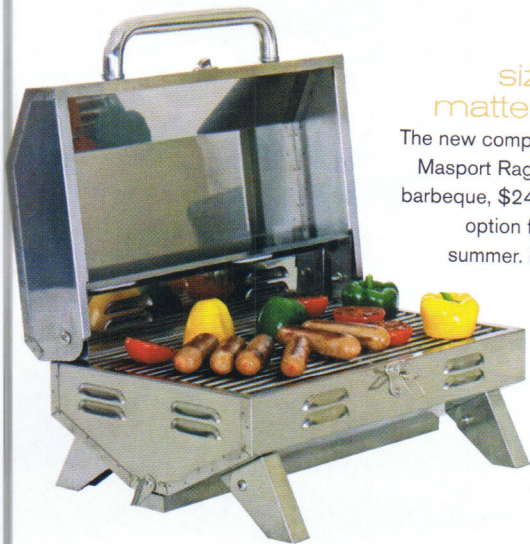
greatest hits

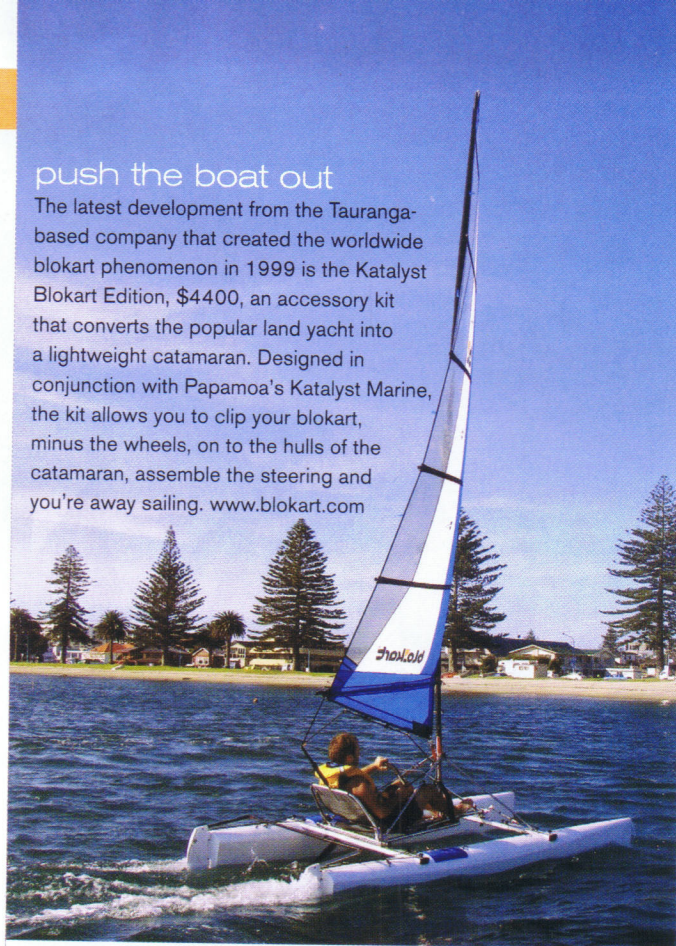
